

Endless fun and entertainment

pion whip cracker, Emi East, as well as sheep shearing, working dog trials, wood chopping, and new addition, the Great Dino Race, to go along with numerous

food and drink stalls.


The huge free kids entertainment zone will have an animal petting zoo, Black Snake

Staying Healthy

The Bairnsdale Seventh Day Adventist (SDA) church will be holding a health expo at the East Gippsland Field Days for the first time this year.

The Bairnsdale SDA will have a series of eight health-related stations, offering basic health checks and providing resources to improve your health.

The stations range from nutrition and discussing your diet and healthy eating habits, getting your blood pressure taken, talking about cholesterol levels and the benefits of drinking enough water every day, to a massage chair to help you relax, both mentally and physically.

At the end of the eight stations, participants will be able to discuss their results and receive their estimated health age.

A health age estimation is designed to give you an idea of your overall health, and is a general indication of how lifestyle related factors, such as alcohol consumption, smoking, or an unhealthy diet, may affect it.

The expo focuses on the motto, "prevention is better than a cure," and is aiming to help participants detect illness before it becomes



Rural student scholarships available

The Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS) Victoria is this year offering five \$5000 scholarships to rural university students studying nursing or an allied health discipline - and applications are opening soon.

The Give Them Wings scholarship program, which began in 2012, recognises the added expenses that students from rural and remote locations often face when studying, and provides financial assistance to help these students complete their course.

In 2023, the scholarships will also offer recipients the chance to spend up to a week with a Flying Doctor team related to their field of study, in order to expose students to what it is like to work in health care in a rural setting.

Studies have shown health students who undertake rural placements are more likely to seek employment in those communities upon graduation, and this new work experience model is therefore intended to support local communities to recruit and retain health care professionals in the future.

2022 scholarship

recipient and optometry student, Charlotte Mullens, last year became the very first student to undertake an extended work experience opportunity through the Give Them Wings program, as she joined the Flying Doctor Mobile Eye Care team on a week-long trip to Cann River and Goongerah in Far East Gippsland.

"It was incredible to spend a week immersed in optometry and see the principles of the Flying Doctor in action," Charlotte said.

"We saw patients who had lost everything in the bushfires and who were grappling with feeling forgotten through years of unprecedented times, [but] who felt seen and valued by the Flying Doctor's outreach health services.

"The Flying Doctor experience inspired me, and assured me that working in regional health care is my calling. I feel excited and thrilled about the opportunity to fulfil my purpose."

Also new for 2023, applications for the Give Them Wings scholarship program will be open to undergraduate students of all year levels, rather than only those in their

first yea

This decision was motivated by a desire to ensure all Victorian students who are passionate about improving health outcomes in rural and remote Victoria have the best chance of graduating and pursuing their goals.

"At RFDS Victoria, we are always looking for ways in which we can use our expertise to support rural health workforce development and training," RFDS Victoria chief executive, Scott Chapman, said.

"By evolving our scholarship program to include a more in-depth work experience component, we feel that we will be able to provide invaluable mentorship opportunities to those students who will hopefully become eager members of the next generation of rural health care professionals."

Applications for the Give Them Wings scholarship program are now open and will close on Friday, April 28.

Free health checks with Latrobe Health

Gippsland's local and not-forprofit private health insurer, Latrobe Health Services, has partnered with Priceline Pharmacy, SiSU Health, and Novartis to bring free 15-minute heart health checks to East Gippsland Field Days this month.

Latrobe Health Services chief executive officer, lan Whitehead, said as Gippsland has some of the

poorest cardiovascular health outcomes in Australia, this initiative is one way to help our members and community check if they are at risk.

"We're passionate about supporting better health our community," Mr Whitehead said.

"Gippsland has some of the worst heart health outcomes in Australia, so we're encouraging our members and community to participate in the heart health screenings.

Results will be provided immediately following the test, with the pharmacist providing key insights on the results, advice on how to keep your heart healthy, and inform you on how to follow up with your GP in further action is required," Mr Whitehead said.

A trained clinician will facilitate the 15-minute test to check key heart health indicators including blood pressure; heart rate, body composition, diabetes risk, and non-fasting cholesterol levels.

According to Amy Sabatini, chief pharmacist with Priceline, coronary heart disease remains the dominant cause of death among Australians with worse outcomes experienced in regional and rural

"It is important to get heart health check-ups to give you the best chance of receiving the right treatment and possibly diagnosing underlying medical conditions," Ms Sabatini said.

The free heart health checks are open to all East Gippsland Field Day attendees aged 18 years and over at 8a in the General Interest site.



Leebrooke Livestock makes a mark

When Jessica Lee and her husband, Matthew, took on the East Gippsland cattle property that had been in his family for six generations, they knew they were ready to make their own mark.

Their vision was to build a flock of exceptional quality sheep, to run alongside their Angus cattle.

Born and raised on well-known Hillcreston Superfine Merino Stud near Bigga on the Southern Tablelands of New South Wales, Jess had the sheep experience to do it, but there were questions as to whether the breed she had grown up with would suit the conditions where she now lived.

"When we moved here five years ago, we realised Merinos just weren't suited to our land," Jessica said.

"So, we made the decision to go with the self-replacing, haired, meat sheep Australian Whites, because they are hardy and well-suited to a range of conditions.

"We were also mindful of the availability of shearers, with so many producers in our area looking for something they can run without having to have specific skills or experience.

"We thought, let's take a leap on this breed and see how it goes, and established Leebrooke Australian Whites - and we've never looked back."

Today, Jessica and Matthew, along with their children Evelyn, 7, Sylvia, 5, and Jim, 3, run both a stud and commercial operation, carrying primarily Tattykeel and Gamadale genetics and have recently completed an embryo transfer program to boost their genetics.

They have been meticulous in the process of selectively building their flock to ensure they could achieve the quality and correct breeding traits that are true to the Australian White breed.

Additionally, the family grazes 150 Angus breeders with a focus on fertility, growth and structure.

Originally developed for Australian conditions, Australian Whites require minimal maintenance and are starting to surge in popularity.

The breed has a reputation for being lice and fly free, having fast growth rates, high fertility and a good temperament, which Jessica said makes them easy to manage, as they require very little intervention.

"You almost run them like cattle, they're so hardy. We've seen a wide range of weather conditions over the last few years and they have continued to perform and require little intervention on our part".

However, the Lees have also been captivated by Australian Whites' "unreal, distinct difference" in meat quality.

"When we got into the breed there was a lot of hype around that factor but before we started talking about that we really LEEBROOKE

wanted to make sure we could breed it. Now, we can attest this is one hundred per cent true," Jessica said.

Leebrooke branded lamb will be featured on the menu at Maffco Brewery and Taphouse in their restaurant when it opens in the near future. Maffco aims to serve local produce and showcase products that are grown and developed in Gippsland, so it was the perfect opportunity to supply them with local Australian White lamb which is high in omega three and has a low melting point.

With a clear goal of establishing a premium-quality brand, Jessica and Matthew have been meticulous in the process of selectively building their flock.

Last year, they felt the time was right to move ahead with their own small, but high-calibre on-property sale in February 2022

"We had gotten to the point where we had a few years of breeding rams and were feeling like we were at a place where our stock was quite consistent and were confident each of the rams we offered would go out and perform," lessica said.

The "gamble" proved both calculated and expertly executed, with Leebrooke's inaugural offering averaging \$5517 and topping at \$8750 for Lot 11, Leebrooke 210028, secured by Scott Norman from Moyston Australian Whites in Western Victoria.

With a sale planned for Spring of 2023, Matt and Jess will offer another quality line up of AWSBA Blue Flock Tags rams.

"We'd love anyone who is interested in Australian Whites to get in contact with us and get on our mailing list for information about our upcoming sale. We will keep our reserve at an affordable price for our second Annual sale because we just want to get all the rams out there so people can see what we've got and hopefully come back. The breed still has a lot of potential in East Gippsland and we hope to see others achieving the same success that we have had".

Continuing push to stop Fingerboards project

On November 24, 2021, the Victorian Minister for Planning announced that he had assessed the environmental risks of Kalbar's Fingerboards mineral sands mine project as "unacceptable". In his media release that day he stated the mine "will not proceed".

Kalbar Operations recently changed its company name to Gippsland Critical Minerals to again seek approval to mine at the same location for rare earth elements which are also known as 'critical minerals'.


According to a Policy Position Paper adopted by Public Health Association Australia, there are "potential serious health and environmental risks" from mining rare earth elements. The paper states: "Rare earth elements coexist with radioactive minerals such as uranium and thorium. Rare earths mining should be opposed except in very sparsely populated areas of Australia."

"Over 4000 hectares of horticulture fields in the Lindenow Valley are as close as 500m downwind from the mine licence boundary and hundreds of people live, farm and work nearby which are some of the many reasons why Kalbar's Fingerboards mine project was not given environmental approval," Mine-Free Glenaladale spokesperson, Debbie Carruthers, said.

"Our mining legislation says it's not acceptable to mine anywhere; it must be environmentally safe to do so. It's not mining at any cost, nor to the detriment of other sustainable long-term industries, nor to people's health and wellbeing.

"The Fingerboards continues to be the wrong location for a mine. Changing the company's name and rebranding the ore body doesn't remove the severe environmental impacts that were the basis of environmental approval not being given."

"I will be attending this year's event with my family and hope to see you there," he said.


